OVERVIEW

The CBL State Savings Bank Foundation administers a scholarship program designed to support the educational pursuits of high school seniors residing in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties, the communities CBL serves. This program reflects the Foundation's commitment to fostering future leaders in the banking industry and the skilled trades that support our local economies.

APPLICATION TIMELINE

Scholarship applications will be accepted annually. All completed applications must be received by the close of business on March 1. If that date falls on a weekend, the deadline will shift to the <u>preceding</u> business day. Scholarship recipients will be selected and notified by May 15, with funds disbursed directly to the recipient's institution before the fall semester.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. **High School Senior Status**: Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in the current academic year.
- 2. **Geographic Location**: Applicant must live in Greenville or Spartanburg County.
- College Enrollment: Applicant must be accepted into a 4-year degree program at an accredited college or university.
- 4. **Field of Study**: Applicant must plan to pursue a four-year degree in a banking-related field such as finance, accounting, business administration, economics, or cybersecurity.
- 5. **Academic Performance**: Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 6. **CBL Relatives**: Relatives of CBL State Savings Bank employees and directors are not eligible to apply for this scholarship. This includes, but is not limited to, spouses, children, grandchildren, siblings, parents, nieces, and nephews.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. **Completed Application Form**: All sections must be filled out accurately and completely.
- 2. **Personal Essay:** A personal essay (500–750 words) that outlines the applicant's career goals, demonstrates a strong interest in pursuing a career in the banking industry, and explains how receiving this scholarship will support them in achieving those goals.
- 3. **Letters of Recommendation**: Two letters of recommendation from teachers, counselors, or community leaders who can attest to the applicant's academic achievements, character, and potential.
- 4. Official High School Transcript: Must include the most recent grades and GPA.
- 5. **Proof of College Acceptance**: A copy of the acceptance letter from the college or university the applicant plans to attend.
- 6. **Resume**: A current resume highlighting academic achievements, extracurricular activities, work experience, and community service.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors based on academic performance, community involvement, leadership, clarity of career goals that align with the banking industry, and alignment with the Foundation's mission.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. **Submission Deadline**: All application materials must be submitted **by 5:00 pm on Friday**, **February 27, 2026**.
- 2. **Submission Method**: Applications can be submitted electronically via scholarships@myCBL.bank or mailed to 229 Trade Street, Greer, SC 29651.
- Notification: Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone, email, or during their school's awards ceremony. Applicants who are not selected will not receive individual notification.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- 1. Amount: The scholarship amount will be \$5,000.
- 2. **Number of Awards**: Up to three scholarships will be granted, with one scholarship awarded to each recipient.
- 3. **Disbursement**: Funds will be disbursed directly to the recipient's college or university to be applied towards tuition, fees, and other educational expenses.
- 4. **Renewal**: The scholarship is a one-time award and is not renewable.
